## To make your stay more comfortable, please note the following PARK RULES;

- OFFICE HOURS:** 8.30 – 6.00pm daily (5.00pm close Oct-March). Our friendly staff can help you with local information, G'day rewards memberships bookings to other Top Tourist Parks, change for the laundry (\$1 and \$2 coins), cold drinks, ice, gas refills and any other queries to make your stay more enjoyable.
- CHECKOUT:** 10.00am for accommodation and sites. If you wish to extend your stay, fees must be paid at the office by 9.30am. Extensions are subject to availability. Sorry no refunds if you choose to leave earlier than expected.
- SPEED LIMIT:** Strictly 8km/hr (walking pace) throughout the park. Speeding fines in the form of a donation to charity may apply 😊
- VEHICLES:** One per site. Fees may apply for storage of additional vehicles, boats, etc. Please park on your allocated site at all times. Please do not use power tools or carry out mechanical repairs in park. No parking on cement slabs.
- CAR WASHING:** Permitted on your site and preferably where there is grass. You must collect a coloured hose and pay at the office prior to commencing washing. Fee: \$3.00/car & \$6.00/caravan, boat or bus. Please use fresh water taps.
- QUIET TIME:** 10.00pm – 8.00am for the comfort of all. Please respect others.
- CHILDREN:** Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult at all times throughout the park, particularly in amenities blocks, at the playground and around the pool. Parents are responsible for their children's behaviour.
- WATER:** There is good quality drinking water from all taps except the bore water taps. Water is very precious in Carnarvon – please use it wisely. Please feel free to use clean waste water to water a tree and/or grass in the park. Otherwise grass must only be watered with bore water when the pump is running.
- VISITORS:** All visitors must report to the office. Visitors must park in the designated area at the front of the park and not on your site. Overnight visitors attract the usual extra person tariff. If day visitors intend to use facilities such as the pool, showers and camp kitchen, a day fee applies.
- PETS:** Are permitted in the park at Managers' discretion. Fees and Conditions Apply. Application forms available from office. Animals are not permitted in designated accommodation or communal areas (laundry, camp kitchen, dishwashing room). Pets must be kept on a short leash at all times. Please pick up after them.
- SWIMMING POOL:** Seasonal and open during office hours. Children under 10 must be supervised by an adult at all times. Please no glass or smoking in pool area.
- EQUIPMENT HIRE:** Lawn bowls, mats, jacks and DVDs can be borrowed from the office. A \$10.00 deposit applies. Additional charges apply for DVDs and bowling green fees. For information regarding daily bowls from June-Sept, please see notice board in Dishwashing room opposite Camp Kitchen.
- CAMP KITCHEN:** Free BBQs, stove, microwave, kettle, toaster, 1 fridge and digital TV. Please leave BBQs and camp kitchen clean for the next guest.
- RECREATION ROOM:** Open for scheduled activities (please see office staff for details).
- FISH CLEANING:** Please use the new facility located at the Small Boat Harbour. For cleaning of small catches there is a basic facility at the rear of our park. ALL FISH SCRAPS MUST BE WRAPPED IN NEWSPAPER AND PLASTIC BAGS AND DISPOSED OF IN BINS AT FISH CLEANING AREA. No fish cleaning on sites, camp kitchen or in accommodation please.
- DUMP POINT:** Located at the rear of our park (see map overleaf) or on Hill Street in town (turn left after Chicken Treat). Please only use our park facility if you use eco-friendly chemicals in your toilet. Wet wipes block up our system. Please do not use our dump point if you have disposed of wet wipes in your cassette
- CLOTHES LINES:** Temporary lines between sites, trees and verandahs are not permitted. There are a number of clothes lines located outside the laundries.
- WIFI:** Our free WIFI service will be detectable by suitable devices. To access it, please accept the terms and conditions.
- RUBBISH STATIONS:** See map overleaf. For bagged rubbish only. You are responsible for disposing of large rubbish items such as damaged deck chairs outside of the caravan park.
- RECYCLING:** Please crush aluminium cans and dispose of them in the mesh cages. Proceeds to charity.
